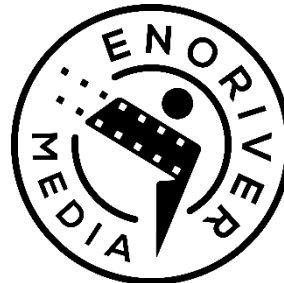


Eno River Media Logo Symbolism

Adopted in the mid 2000s, the current Eno River Media Logo has had two variations.

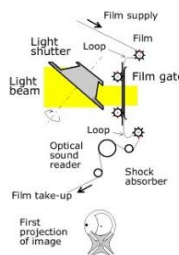


The circular icon is the current logo and was adopted in 2012. The logo itself symbolizes several concepts representing the arts; filmmaking, dance, creative writing, and a sense of home for the arts community.



Most distinctive is the film strip representing motion pictures. The symbolic aspects to the logo are as follows; a dancer, a house, a film strip in a film projector, and a quill pen.

The round dot represents a sprocket in a film projector. The round dot also represents the head of a ballet dancer where the film strip represents the arms raised back above the head of a dance leaping into the air. The curled bottom of the film strip represents a quill pen. The film strip and curled edge also represents the outline of a house where the house is only shown in one half, with the roof forming an eave and the right side of a house structure. The image taken overall represents a ballet dancer in mid flight with her arms above her head.



The round circle with the organization's name represents an eternal process of reinvention and hope for the future.
